# **Lound Pony Draw**

- There are 150 tickets, numbered 1-150 (surprise!)
- In June, villagers already holding tickets will be visited and asked if they wish to purchase their ticket for the following year for £25
- If they do not, or are no longer in the village, their ticket will be offered to someone previously without a ticket
- The first draw of the year takes place in July
- Each monthly draw takes place in the presence of witnesses
- There are two bags one containing counters with the numbers 1-150 and the other containing counters with Win or Roll Over
- Four numbers are drawn from the number bag each month and each of those ticket owners will receive £25 (a "Pony" in Cockney Rhyming Slang)
- Those numbers are then returned to the number bag
- One counter is drawn from the second bag
- If it's a win, the owner of that ticket wins £50
- If it's a Roll Over, no one gets the £50, and it goes on to the next month where the "Win" will be £100 and so on.....
